

On-Camp Housing form

(This form must be filled out and mailed or faxed if you are interested in staying at Camp Mishawaka)

Camp Mishawaka is providing On-Camp Housing for Centennial attendees who wish to stay at camp during the celebration. Housing is broken down into four levels based on amenities and space. We thought this would be the best way to accommodate as many people as possible.

All options except Level 1 have set pricing. Please bid on or check appropriate boxes for the cabins you wish to occupy. This form must be received by January 1st.

At that time, cabins will be designated and lotteries will be held to determine occupancy for cabins with multiple interests. We will contact you by January 8th to let you know the results of the bids and lotteries, and arrange for payment.

We recommend that you reserve a hotel in Grand Rapids in addition to your On-Camp Housing bid. These hotels have liberal cancellation policies and your reservation can be cancelled once your housing has been confirmed.

All housing proceeds go to cabin maintenance/building fund. Lodging is inclusive of a 6.875% Minnesota State Sales Tax. Linens are available at camp – sorry, you have to make your own bed!

This may seem like a cumbersome process but we have tried our best to distribute camp housing in a fair and equitable way.

Level 1

At this level, the cabins will be distributed in the style of a silent auction. Bid an amount per cabin. The highest bid per cabin will take it! If you are the high bidder on more than one cabin, you can choose to honor one or all of your bids.

All cabins include: shower, toilet, sink, electricity, refrigerator, heat, bedroom separate from living space. All prices are for the weekend (Friday and Saturday).

Level 2

These cabins are ideal for extended families that all want to stay under one roof. These cabins also have a single bed slightly separated from the other bunks, traditionally designated for staff members. Numbers include this bed. If there are more requests than available cabins, names will be drawn via a lottery and winners will be notified.

These cabins include: shower, toilet, sink, and electricity. All prices are for the weekend (Friday and Saturday).

- \$300 Lakeside Cabin – Sleeps up to 10
- \$350 Health Center – Sleeps up to 7
- \$400 Parkside (Peg & Fran) – Sleeps up to 15
- \$400 Parkside (Todd & Westgate) Sleeps up to 15
- \$400 Girls CIT Cabin – Sleeps up to 13

Level 3

These cabins have electricity and share bathroom and shower facilities that are within a short distance.

Within this designation, there are options for large and small families. If there are more requests than available cabins, names will be drawn via a lottery and winners will be notified.

All prices are for the weekend (Friday and Saturday).

- \$150 Central Belding – Sleeps 2-3
- \$175 Dickerson – Sleeps up to 9
- \$200 Dahlen – Sleeps up to 10
- \$225 Boys CIT Cabin
Sleeps up to 13
- \$500 Belding – Sleeps up to 28

Level 4

These are the most rustic cabins at camp (Mulford and Gould). They are the traditional “shell” cabins located just off of main campus with no additional amenities. Shower and bathroom facilities are located nearby.

The most economical way to stay at camp, especially for those attending without a family. Price is for the weekend (Friday and Saturday night).

You are buying a bed at camp and will most likely have two or three cabin mates doing the same. We will do our best to honor cabin mate requests, and you will always be placed with the same gender.
